On January 11, 2017, the CCP Workgroup requested additional information specific to the Compliance Response Team (CRT). The information below is provided in response and should be considered in conjunction with the detail provided in the initial memorandum submitted on January 11, 2017.

• BSCC City Law Enforcement Grant - \$140,000 in rollover funds are available for FY17-18.

<u>Service Level Impact</u> - Although it would be difficult to project the potential impact of an
elimination of CRT services, it is reasonable to foresee that absconded and warranted offenders
would remain at large for longer period of times and the number of outstanding warrants would rise.
Additionally, CRT involvement with multi-agency operations would be reduced, which would likely
impact the number of firearms and the amount of controlled substances removed from the
community.

As indicated above, the PRCS/PSS compliance checks remained fairly consistent through 2015 and 2016 at a 12-month average of 209. (A review of prior data submissions reveals they peaked at 254 in FY13-14.) The data provided previously, did not include the final two months of 2016. The chart above has been updated to reflect those numbers. Efforts to be responsive to the original intent and purpose of the CRT are reflected in the increase in compliance checks in the final two months of the calendar year.
