## IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

Based on guidance from the California Department of Public Health and the California Governor's Stay at Home Executive Order N-33-20 issued on March 19, 2020 to protect the health and well-being of all Californian's and to establish consistency across the state in order to slow the spread of COVID-19, the Juvenile Justice Coordinating Council (JJCC) meeting will not provide in-person participation.

We have established alternative methods of participation in the JJCC meetings, pursuant to the California Governor's Executive Order N-29-20, which states:

- Providing an opportunity to "observe and address" telephonically or otherwise electronically, alone, meets the requirement; and
- Removing the former requirement from Executive Order N-25-20 of having "at least one publicly accessible" location from which the public may observe and offer comment. Executive Order N-29-20 now states expressly, "Such a body need not make available any physical location from which members of the public may observe the meeting and offer public comment."

The following alternative methods of participation are available to the public. If you wish to make a general public comment or to comment on a specific agenda item, the following methods are available:

- 7. Youth Empowerment Services (YES) program – Brian Swanson**  
The Youth Reinvestment Grant program was established in the 2018 Budget Act (Senate Bill 840, Chapter 29, Statutes of 2018) and its related trailer bill (Assembly Bill 1812, Chapter 36, Statutes of 2018). Grant funds are provided for programs focused on diverting low-level offenders from initial contact with the juvenile justice system using approaches that are evidence-based, culturally relevant, trauma-informed, and developmentally appropriate. Santa Barbara County Probation, in partnership with the Council on Alcoholism and Drug Abuse (CADA), applied for and received funding to provide diversion services to youth countywide, including academic and vocational education, and behavioral health services.

- 8. Juvenile Hall Trust Unit – Shawn Small & Bill Roberts**  
Using a pilot behavior modification program involving positive incentives, Probation designed and implemented a “Trust Unit” for youth detained in Santa Maria Juvenile Hall (SMJH). Youth who demonstrate ongoing positive behavior can apply to live in the Trust Unit, which has extra comforts, privileges and a less restrictive environment than a standard detention unit. It is believed the opportunity to live in the Trust Unit will improve overall behavior of youth in the units as they strive to be eligible for the unit, thus decreasing behavior issues and room confinement, and increasing safety for youth and staff alike.
