### 7. Commercial Sexual Exploitation of Children (CSEC) Presentation – Dana Roscoe

- Dana Roscoe, the County CSEC Coordinator, made a presentation regarding CSEC in Santa Barbara County. The presentation included questions and discussion from the group.
- The California Partners for Social Services put out a request for proposals for \$11.5 million to address CSEC placements and services. The CSEC collaborative submitted an application for the funding.
- Supervisor Wolf stated CSEC was presented to the Board of Supervisor (BOS) recently but it would be good to bring back additional information to the board members.
- A question was asked regarding after hours crisis services and Dr. Gleghorn clarified that crisis services are available by contacting the crisis number and they will triage.
