**IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING PUBLIC PARTICIPATION**

Based on guidance from the California Department of Public Health and the California Governor's Stay at Home Executive Order N-33-20 issued on March 19, 2020 to protect the health and well-being of all Californian's and to establish consistency across the state in order to slow the spread of COVID-19, the Juvenile Justice Coordinating Council Workgroup (JJCCW) meeting will not provide in-person participation.

We have established alternative methods of participation in the JJCCW meetings, pursuant to the California Governor's Executive Order N-29-20, which states:

- Providing an opportunity to "observe and address" telephonically or otherwise electronically, alone, meets the requirement; and
- Removing the former requirement from Executive Order N-25-20 of having "at least one publicly accessible" location from which the public may observe and offer comment. Executive Order N-29-20 now states expressly, "Such a body need not make available any physical location from which members of the public may observe the meeting and offer public comment."

The following alternative methods of participation are available to the public. If you wish to make a general public comment or to comment on a specific agenda item, the following methods are available:

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- 5. Development of the Comprehensive Multi-Agency Juvenile Justice Plan (CMJJP) – Brian Swanson, Karyn Milligan**  
Assembly Bill (AB) 1913, the Schiff-Cardenas Crime Prevention Act of 2000 (Chapter 353), created the Juvenile Justice Crime Prevention Act (JJCPA) program. The JJCPA provides a stable funding source for local juvenile justice programs aimed at curbing crime and delinquency among at-risk youth. Counties are required to complete and annually update a Comprehensive Multi-Agency Juvenile Justice Plan (CMJJP) describing objectives and strategies for working with this population. As per the Workplan for developing the CMJJP, the Workgroup will receive a series of presentations to facilitate discussion and development of the Plan.

- 6. Selection Process for Recommendation to the JJCC – Holly Benton**  
Senate Bill (SB) 823, Juvenile Justice Realignment, chaptered September 30, 2020, creates the Office of Youth and Community Restoration (OYCR), prohibits the commitment of additional youth to the Division of Juvenile Justice (DJJ) effective July 1, 2021, and realigns responsibility for these youth to the counties. Beginning in FY 2022-23, the legislation requires a plan to accept funding for this purpose, to be developed and approved by a subcommittee of the Juvenile Justice Coordinating Council (JJCC).
