4. **All-County Information Notice (ACIN) I-68-18** – Holly Benton
ACIN I-68-18 provides information regarding the allocation of funding provided pursuant to Assembly Bill (AB) 1811 for the purpose of providing community-based services to reduce the frequency of law enforcement involvement and delinquency petitions arising from incidents at facilities licensed to provide residential care to dependent children. Review the ACIN and discuss implications for Santa Barbara County youth.

The Youth Reinvestment Grant will provide funding to be awarded to local jurisdictions through a competitive grant process for implementing evidence-based, trauma-informed, culturally relevant, and developmentally appropriate diversion programs in underserved communities with high rates of juvenile arrests and high rates of racial/ethnic disproportionality within those juvenile arrests.
