- 5. Juvenile Justice Realignment Holly Benton
  - Holly Benton provided a review of Senate Bill (SB) 823, Juvenile Justice Realignment, which creates the Office of Youth and Community Restoration, prohibits the commitment of additional youth from juvenile court to the Division of Juvenile Justice (DJJ) effective July 1, 2021, and realigns responsibility for these youth to the counties.
  - Beginning in FY 2022-23 the legislation requires a plan to accept funding for this purpose, to be developed and approved by a subcommittee of the JJCC.
