2/3/21	Santa Maria Juvenile Hall	1-Staff	No youth were exposed.
2/12/21	Santa Maria Juvenile Hall	1-Staff	Staff and youth identified and tested; all tested negative.
2/18/21	Santa Maria Juvenile Hall	1-Youth	Youth was detected during the intake process and is a community exposure; no staff or youth were exposed. The youth is being housed in a medical observation unit.
4/7/21	Santa Maria Juvenile Hall	1-Staff	No youth exposed; exposed staff tested negative.
4/28/21	Santa Maria Juvenile Hall	1-Youth	No staff or other youth exposed.
7/1/21	Santa Maria Juvenile Hall & Los Prietos Boys Camp	2-Staff (1-SMJH) (1-LPBC)	Exposed staff and youth identified and tested; all tested negative.
8/8/21	Santa Maria Juvenile Hall	1-Staff	Exposed staff and youth identified and tested; all tested negative.

The Probation Department has a comprehensive COVID-19 Management Plan. Employees and contractors are required to submit to temperature and health questionnaire screening prior to entering the facility and have been directed not to come to work ill.

The Probation Department remains focused on being responsive to the mental and physical well-being of youth, staff and contractors during this challenging and stressful situation, and is taking steps to ensure their wellness. The Department is continuing to make decisions based on best practices in health and safety standards for the youth under their care, their officers, and the community.
