INSTITUTION STAFF ASSIGNED TO SANTA MARIA JUVENILE HALL TESTS COVID-19 POSITIVE

(SANTA MARIA, CA) – Chief Probation Officer Tanja Heitman reported today that a juvenile institutions officer assigned to the Santa Barbara Probation Department's Santa Maria Juvenile Hall (SMJH) notified the Department they tested positive for COVID-19.

The Probation Department has a comprehensive COVID-19 Management Plan that addresses this situation. Employees and contractors are required to submit to temperature and health questionnaire screening prior to entering the facility and have been directed not to come to work ill. In this case, the staff left the facility early after feeling mild symptoms and tested with their personal physician. The test subsequently returned positive. The officer continues to experience mild symptoms, but is self-isolating at home and showing improvement. The Department is conducting contact tracing. Although the staff consistently wore a face mask while on duty, the Department will coordinate the testing of all youth and staff that had close or sustained contact with the staff as a precaution. The SMJH medical unit is coordinating contact tracing and testing with the Santa Barbara County Public Health Department.

The Probation Department remains focused on being responsive to the mental and physical well-being of youth, staff and contractors during this challenging and stressful situation, and is taking steps to ensure their wellness. The Department is continuing to make decisions based on best practices in health and safety standards for the youth under their care, their officers, and the community.
